Polls closed for S' pure presidential election Indian-origin ex-min in race

PTI ■ SINGAPORE Voting in Singapore's first contested presidential election since 2011 closed on Friday, a closely-watched three-way race in which former minister Tharman Shanmugaratnam is seeking to become the next Singapore-born Indian-origin head of the state. The polls closed at 8 PM (local time). Ballot boxes are being sealed and transported to counting centres, where a sample count will be done to get an early indication of the possible outcome. The country will wait for the returning officer's announcement to know the election result, which could be different from the sample count. Anish Patel, a 33-year-old Indian-origin sales engineer, said he voted for the first time in a presidential election and



the voting process was "very fast". He said he decided to cast his ballot at a late hour after hearing that his friends encountered queues in the morning. The polls ended with over 2.7 million voters casting their ballots. This was Singapore's first presidential election in 12 years as the last one in 2017 - which was reserved for Malay candidates - was uncontested. Incumbent President

Madam Halimah Yacob was the only eligible candidate and she was sworn in after the Nomination Day on September 13, 2017. Halimah decided not to seek a second term. The three candidates for the 2023 presidential election are former senior minister Tharman, former chief investment officer with the Government of Singapore Investment Corp (GIC), and former chief of the NTUC Income, a state-owned union-based insurance group, Tan Kin Lian. Eligible voters started casting their ballots at 8 AM when polling stations opened. Voting is compulsory for which the government has declared Friday a public holiday. Singaporeans will get an early indication of the outcome of the presidential election at around 10 PM to 11 PM, before the final count is in.

Putin, Erdogan to meet amid efforts to repair Ukraine grain deal

AP ■ MOSCOW Russian President Vladimir Putin will host Turkish leader Recep Tayyip Erdogan for talks in Russia's Black Sea resort of Sochi on Monday, the Kremlin announced on Friday, just over six weeks after Moscow broke off a deal partly brokered by Ankara that allowed Ukrainian grain to reach world markets despite the 18-month war. Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov announced the talks Friday, ending weeks of speculation about when and where the two leaders might meet next as international efforts continue to patch up the Black Sea Grain Initiative which got grain and other food to Africa, the Middle East and Asia where hunger is a growing threat. Turkey, together with the United Nations, brokered a deal in July 2022 that allowed Ukraine to ship grain and other foodstuffs from three Black Sea ports. A separate memorandum

between the UN and Russia, agreed at the same time, pledged to overcome obstacles to Moscow's shipment of food and fertiliser to world markets. However, Russia pulled out of the deals earlier this year, claiming that its conditions hadn't been met. On Thursday, Russian Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov hosted his Turkish counterpart for talks in Moscow. UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres sent Russia a new proposal in hopes of reviving the deal but it didn't satisfy Moscow's demands, Lavrov said then. Lavrov said he had given Ankara a list of actions that the West would have to take in order to resume Ukrainian grain and fertiliser shipments. Talks between Putin and Erdogan could help unlock that. The agreement had allowed Ukraine to ship almost 33,000 tons of grain at a time of growing global hunger.

UN chief sends Russia new proposals to revive Black Sea grain deal

United Nations (AP): The United Nations chief sent Russia a new proposal aimed at getting its grain and fertilizer to global markets in hopes of reviving the deal that allowed Ukraine to ship almost 33,000 tons of grain at a time of growing global hunger. But Moscow wasn't satisfied with the letter that UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres sent Russian Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov earlier this week. Speaking at a press conference on Thursday after meeting with Turkish Foreign Minister Hakan Fidan, Lavrov said he had given Ankara a list of actions that the West would have to take in order to resume Ukrainian shipments. The United Nations and Turkey brokered the deal in July 2022 that allowed Ukraine to ship grain and other foodstuffs

from three Black Sea ports. A separate memorandum between the UN and Russia pledged to overcome obstacles to Moscow's shipment of food and fertilizer to world markets. The deal followed Russia's Feb. 24, 2022, invasion of Ukraine which sent global food prices skyrocketing because the two countries are major "breadbaskets" for the world. Guterres told UN reporters on Thursday that he had written a letter to Lavrov with "a set of concrete proposals, allowing to create the conditions for the renewal of the Black Sea initiative." He did not give any details other than to say, "we have some concrete solutions for the concerns allowing for an effective, or more effective access of Russian food and fertilizers at adequate prices."

Russia reports three more drone attacks

Moscow (AP): Russian officials said on Friday that air defences intercepted three of the country's western regions, while satellite images indicated that a major drone barrage earlier in the week destroyed at least two Ilyushin Il-76 military transport planes at a Russian air base. Regional governors said defence systems stopped three drones in the Kursk, Belgorod and Moscow regions. Moscow airports briefly halted flights but no major damage or injuries were reported, according to Russian authorities. Drones aimed at targets inside Russia — and blamed by Moscow on Ukraine — have become almost a daily occurrence as the war has entered its 19th month and Kyiv's forces pursue a counteroffensive. Recently, the drones have reached deeper into Russia. Kyiv officials normally neither claim nor deny responsibility for attacks on Russian soil.

Nobel body reverses invitation policy

AP ■ STOCKHOLM The Nobel Foundation that administers the prestigious awards, has reversed its invitation policy and invited Russia, Belarus and Iran, as well as the leader of a far-right Swedish party, who had previously been banned. Vidar Helgesen, the executive director of the private foundation said in a statement that there was a global trend in which "dialogue between those with differing views is being

reduced." To counter that, he said, "we are now broadening our invitations to celebrate and understand the Nobel Prize and the importance of free science, free culture and free, peaceful societies." The foundation said that invitation for the 2023 events was extended to all countries with diplomatic missions in Sweden and Norway and parties "that have parliamentary representation via democratic elections," adding that "this common approach promotes opportunities to con-

vey the important messages of the Nobel Prize to everyone, and in future this practice will be common to the entire organisation." Last year, the diplomatic envoys of Russia and Belarus were barred from attending the glittery prize ceremonies and banquets, which always take place on December 10, because of the war in Ukraine, and the ambassador of Iran was also excluded because of "the serious and escalating situation" in the country.

'Russia-China alliance biggest threat since WWII'

AP ■ STOCKHOLM The United States House Foreign Affairs chair said Friday that a partnership of the Russian and Chinese leaders worried him, adding, "We have never seen a threat this large-scale to Europe and the Pacific, I would argue, since World War II." The alliance of Chinese leader Xi Jinping and Russian President Vladimir Putin "provides a very big challenge I think for the free world in this great power competition that we

find ourselves in," said Rep. Michael McCaul, R-Texas, during a visit to Sweden. Earlier in the year, the Biden administration warned Xi's government of unspecified consequences if it supports the Kremlin's war effort in Ukraine. A United States intelligence report said Beijing possibly provided equipment used in Ukraine that might have military applications. The report cited Russian customs data that showed Chinese state-owned military contractors supplied navigation equipment, fighter jet parts, drones and other goods, but didn't say whether that might trigger U.S. retaliation. China has stepped up purchases of Russian oil and gas,

which helps Putin's government offset lost sales after the United States, Europe and Japan cut off most purchases of Russian energy. Beijing can do that without triggering Western sanctions on its own companies, but Washington and its allies are frustrated that it undercuts economic pressure on Moscow. China rejects Western trade and financial sanctions on Russia because they weren't authorized by the United Nations Security Council, where Beijing and Moscow have veto power. However, China has appeared to avoid directly defying those sanctions. McCaul, who was part of a U.S. Congressional Delegation visiting Sweden and met with Swedish Foreign Minister

Tobias Billstrom, said he expects the Nordic country to join NATO by October. Long-neutral Sweden applied for NATO membership together with neighbouring Finland in 2022. New entries must be approved by all existing members, and as NATO leaders met for a summit in Vilnius, Lithuania, Sweden was missing the green light from two: Turkey and Hungary. Finland, which shares a 1,340-kilometer (832-mile) border with Russia — more than doubling the size of NATO's border with Russia — became the 31st member of the world's biggest military alliance in April. But it wasn't until a NATO summit in July that Turkey's president agreed to send the accession documents to the Turkish Parliament for approval, something he had

refused to do for more than a year. By having Finland and Sweden in NATO, "I think it's been will achieve the exact opposite effect that Mr. Putin wanted to achieve, and that was to weaken and divide NATO," McCaul said. With the two Nordic neighbours in NATO, the alliance has "never been stronger and more united." The visiting U.S. Congressional Delegation also included Gregory Meeks, D-N.Y.; Ann Wagner, R-Mo.; Gerry Connolly, D-Va.; Madeleine Dean, D-Pa.; Thomas Keane, R-N.J.; and Bill Huizenga, R-Mich. After Stockholm they were to travel to the Netherlands for bilateral meetings with Dutch government officials and members of parliament, among others.
