CM plants sapling in BSF camp under *Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam* Drive



hief Minister Rekha Gupta on Monday planted a sapling while participating in a large-scale plantation drive under the *Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam* campaign at the BSF Camp, Chhawla, as part of the ongoing 'Green Delhi' mission. The initiative was both a significant step towards environmental conservation and a tribute to the sacrifice and dedication of BSF personnel. Speaking on the occasion, the Chief Minister said the drive reflects Prime Minister Narendra Modi's commitment to environmental protection and his respect for motherhood, adding that the campaign will play a crucial role in achieving the Green Delhi mission's objectives. She described the day as "historic," noting that 1,000 mango saplings were planted at the BSF Camp, contributing to a total of 100,000 saplings planted across Delhi in a single day. Praising the BSF, she posted on X: "I salute the brave soldiers of the Border Security Force, whose sacrifice, dedication, and service have strengthened the foundation of nation-building. Today, as they protect our borders while also contributing to this green mission, the campaign becomes even more meaningful."

# HM Amit Shah to inaugurate All India Speakers' conference

Delhi Assembly Speaker Vijender Gupta on Monday announced that the Union Home Minister Amit Shah will inaugurate the All India Speakers' Conference on August 24.

Addressing a press conference, Gupta said that 32 Speakers and Deputy Speakers, chairman and deputy chairman, have confirmed their participation in the event.

"This is the first time in India that such an event is happening. The inaugural session of the conference will be held on 24 August at 11:00 AM, inaugurated by the Union Home Minister Amit Shah. The session will also

witness the release of a commemorative postage stamp by the Union Minister for Communications and Development of North Eastern Region Jyotiraditya M Scindia. The valedictory session on 25 August 2025 will be presided over by the Speaker of the Lok Sabha Om Birla," he said.

The thematic sessions will include : Vitthalbhai Patel's role in the making of India's Constitution and parliamentary institutions; the role of pre-Independence Central Legislative Assembly leaders in the freedom struggle and social reforms; Artificial Intelligence and its relationship with transparency, accountability, and trust in governments; and India as the Mother of Democracy.

Speaker underscored the Assembly's unique historical position, recalling how this building-constructed in 1912 after Delhi became the capital in 1911-witnessed the earliest legislative debates on education for all, the abolition of exploitative labour contracts, and women's suffrage. It was here that leaders such as Lala Lajpat Rai, Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya, and Gopal Krishna Gokhale used the legislative forum to challenge colonial policies. It was also here that opposition to the Rowlatt Act ignited the Non-Cooperation Movement, revealing the oppressive nature of British rule.

The conference will feature a grand exhibition and a specially commissioned documentary celebrating Patel's

life, parliamentary contributions, and role in India's freedom movement.

Gupta informed that key Note Speaker's addressing the conference will include Deputy Chairman of the Rajya Sabha Harivansh Narayan Singh; Union Minister of Culture and Minister of Tourism Gajendra Singh Shekhawat; Union Minister of Parliamentary Affairs Kiren Rijiju and former Lok Sabha Speaker Meira Kumar.

Lieutenant Governor Vinai Kumar Saxena, Delhi Chief Minister Rekha Gupta, Deputy Speaker Mohan Singh Bisht, and Delhi Cabinet Minister Parvesh Sahib Singh will also participate, Gupta informed. Delhi MPs and MLAs will also participate in the conference.

# DJB begins upgrade of Yamuna Vihar STP

The Board meeting of the Delhi Jal Board (DJB) has ratified administrative approval of the estimate for the work of "Augmentation and up-gradation of existing 25 MGD to 40 MGD STP at Yamuna Vihar Ph-III & construction of new 15 MGD STP at Yamuna Vihar Ph-IV along with operation and maintenance for 12 years at total cost of ₹403 crores.

The Board also approved a proposal for the work of "Upgradation and capacity augmentation of Keshopur STP Phase-I from 12 to 18 MGD along with 11years comprehensive operation & maintenance" a total cost of ₹133.33 Crores.

# LG to lay foundation stone of new clock tower

Delhi Lieutenant Governor Vinai Kumar Saxena on Monday laid the foundation stone of an iconic Clock Tower being built at the junction of Shankar Road and Mandir Marg (near Talkatora Stadium). The nearly 27 meter tall octagonal Clock Tower is being developed in New Delhi by New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC).

The project was approved by the Delhi Urban Art Commission (DUAC), and is

designed to be a timeless symbol and a new landmark for the National Capital.

The eight sides of the Clock Tower would be 12-metre each and will be constructed with reinforced cement concrete and clay bricks. With a project timeline of six months and an estimated cost of ₹1.80 crore, the structure is designed to be a striking blend of Hindu, Mughal, and Colonial architecture, thereby reviving the heritage charm of the Capital.

Speaking on the occasion, Saxena said, "Construction of the new Clock Tower by NDMC will script a new chapter in the urban redevelopment of the national capital. This Clock Tower at Mandir Marg is positioned at the strategic intersection of Mandir Marg and Shankar Road."

# Discoms warn against metal-coated kite strings ahead of Independence Day

Ahead of Independence Day, power distribution entities in Delhi urged people not to use metal-coated strings for flying kites, saying it poses a "severe risk" to life and disrupts electricity supply. The advisory on Monday said its use has been linked to numerous accidents, injuries, and large-scale power outages across the city. Every year, this hazardous string endangers lives, disrupts power supply, and jeopardizes public safety-especially during high kite-flying seasons like Independence Day. People in the city enjoy kite flying every year during

Independence Day.

A BSES spokesperson said, "Metal-coated manjha, very effective in cutting the opponent's kite string, is a deadly conductor of electricity. Its use has been linked to numerous accidents, injuries, and large-scale power outages across the city." Metal-coated strings not only pose a "severe risk" to life but also lead to disruption in power supply through tripping, affecting thousands of people, the spokesperson added.

Metal-coated kite strings endanger lives, disrupt power supply, and jeopardize public safety, especially during high kite-flying seasons like Independence Day, said the BSES

spokesperson.

The Tata Power Delhi Distribution Limited (TPDDL) has also appealed to its customers to be mindful of the electrical network and use cotton strings or any other natural fibre instead of the metal-coated manjha.

Raj Kumar Rastogi, the chief of operations and safety at TPDDL, said, "We urge everyone to fly kites away from electrical wires and installations, as it can lead to power tripping and even serious accidents." The tripping of a single 33/66 KV overhead line can disrupt power for over 10,000 residents, while a single 11 KV line can affect over 2,500 residents. Each year, multiple instances of kite-flying

related trippings are reported, he said.

The threat extends beyond power disruptions. Reckless kite flying, especially with metal-coated strings, can lead to severe injuries or even electrocution for the flyer if it comes in contact with live wires or other electrical installations.

The discom has appealed to people, especially family elders and parents, to counsel their children to refrain from using such strings and retrieving kites from electric wires and other such power installations. They have also been conducting an awareness campaign to prevent the use of metal-coated strings in kite flying.
